INTRODUCTION

The OFDA Disaster History provides information on major disasters which have occurred around the world since 1900. Information is more complete on events since 1964 - the year the Office of Foreign Disaster Assistance was created - and includes details on all disasters to which the Office responded with assistance. No records are kept on disasters which occurred within the United States and its territories.*

All OFDA 'declared' disasters are included - i.e., all those in which the Chief of the U.S. Diplomatic Mission in an affected country determined that a disaster existed which warranted U.S. government response. OFDA is charged with responsibility for coordinating all USG foreign disaster relief.

Significant 'non-declared' disasters are also included in the History based on the following criteria:

- Earthquake and volcano disasters are included if the number of people killed is at least six, or the total number killed and injured is 25 or more, or at least 1,000 people are affected, or damage is \$1 million or more.
- Weather disasters except drought (flood, storm, cyclone, typhoon, landslide, heat wave, cold wave, etc.) are included if the number of people killed and injured totals at least 50, or 1,000 or more are homeless or affected, or damage is at least \$1 million.
- Drought disasters are included if the number affected is substantial.
- Accidents (fire, plane crash, train wreck, etc.) are included if the number of people killed and injured is at least 100, or damage is estimated at \$1 million or more.
- Ocivil strife disasters are not included unless the U.S. government provided relief assistance.

Exceptions to the above have been made in the case of small island countries. Disasters affecting such countries may be included even if the extent of damage is not known because of the relatively greater impact of disasters on small island economies.

In all disasters, the number of people killed and the number affected are recorded as exclusive categories.

The various field headings and acronyms used in this report are explained below.

<u>DISNO (Disaster Number)</u>: The first two digits of the DISNO indicate the fiscal year in which the event occurred; the last three digits are sequence numbers within the fiscal year. Numbers 001 through 100 are assigned to declared disasters and numbers 101 through 999 to undeclared disasters.

STR DT, DECL DT (Strike Date, Declaration Date): The format is Year/Month/Day, e.g., July 4, 1984, would be 84/07/04. The STR DT is the date on which the event began; the DECL DT is the date on which the U.S. Ambassador determined that a disaster had occurred, triggering OFDA response. Absence of a STRIKE DAY or STRIKE MONTH/DAY indicates that the exact beginning date of the disaster is unknown. A declaration date has been supplied for some of the earlier declared disasters if the determination date was not recorded.


Bangladesh Disasters No. of Records (FY 81-90)




Fiji Disasters
No. of Records (FY 81-90)




Philippines Disasters No. of Records (FY 81-90)




















Haiti Disasters No. of Records (FY 81-90)




DISASTERS BY TYPE (FY 81-90) Asia, Near East, South Pacific










DISASTERS BY TYPE AND REGION 1900-FY 1990
