A terrorist bomb ripped apart a sidewalk market place Monday in the northern Israeli resort town of Tiberias, killing two persons and wounding 32. The latest attack threatened to spark a new round of Israeli-Palestinian raids which have left 80 Lebanese and Palestinians dead since April 22. The Israeli government has accused Arafat's Palestine Liberation Organization of responsibility for the midafternoon bombing.
