Puerto Rican terrorists claimed responsibility for bombings in Chicago and Puerto Rico, and New York police were trying to determine if they also planted phony bombs found at Democratic and Republican party offices in Manhattan. Terrorist groups demanding independence from the United States said the bombings were a protest against the U.S. presidential election.

Terrorist blast kills 2, hurts 32 in Israeli resort

A terrorist bomb ripped apart a sidewalk market Monday in the northern Israeli resort town of Tiberias, killing two persons and wounding 32.
