THE HUMANITARIAN RESCUE UNIT OF THE ARMED FORCES OF GUATEMALA WILL CARRY OUT HUMANITARIAN AND RESCUE OPERATIONS UPON REQUEST, IN ANY CENTRAL AMERICAN COUNTRY (MEXICO AND DOMINICAN REPUBLIC) WHERE NATURAL OR MAN MADE DISASTERS OCCUR, IN ORDER TO SAVE AND PROTECT HUMAN LIFE AND MITIGATE DISASTER EFFECTS.

HUMANITARIAN RESCUE UNIT HRU-CFAC OF THE GUATEMALAN ARMED FORCES

PURPOSE

ESTABLISH THE HRU-CFAC TO SATISFY FUTUR SUPPORT REQUIREMENTS OF THE CENTRAL AMERICAN COUNTRIES ON THE EVENT OF A NATURAL OR MAN MADE DISASTER.

HUR-CFAC CAPABILITIES:

- •THE HUMANITARIAN AND RESCUE UNIT HAS THE CAPABILITY TO MANAGE A DISASTER AND MITIGATE ITS CONSEQUENCES IN THE AREA OF OPERATIONS; CAPABILITY IS UNDERSTOOD AS:
- •A. LAND, SEA AND AIR MOBILIZATION.
- **•B.** THE INSTALATION OF NECESARY INFRASTRUCTURE TO OPERATE.
- •C. OPERABILITY IN ANY TERRAIN METHREOLOGICAL CONDITIONS AND ADVERCE SITUATIONS.
- D. MINIMUM FIVE DAY AUTONOMY.

ADMINSTRATIVE PROCEDURES

- UPON THE DECLARATION OF THE EMERGENCY AT THE REQUEST OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE AFFECTED COUNTRY; THE PRESIDENTS AND GENERAL COMMANDERS OF THE COUNTRIES SPARED BY THE EVENT ACTIVATE THE HUMANITARIAN AND RESCUE UNITS THROUGH THE MINISTRIES OR COMMANDERS IN CHIEF OF CFAC MEMBER COUNTRIES.
- ONCE THE MOBILIZATION IS APPROVED BY THE VARIOUS GOVERNMENTS THEY INCORPORATE THEMSELVES INTO THE THE ARMED FORCES OF THE AFFECTED COUNTRY SUPPORTING THE NATIONAL OPERATIONS CENTER OR ITS COUNTERPART.
- THE OPERATIONS AND HUMANITARIAN RESCUE UNIT WILL BE RECOGNIZED BY THE ACRONYMS HUR-CFAC.

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OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

- THE FIELD OF OPERATIONS OF THE HRU-CFACWILL BE HUMANITARIAN AND RESCUE RELIEF OPERATIONS, RESPECTING INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS AND TREATIES ENFORCED IN THE AFFECTED NATIONS.
- THE LEGAL STATUS OF HRU-CFAC WILL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE CHANCERIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH BILATERAL AGREEMENTS.
- THE HRU-CFAC WILL BE ORGANIZED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DISASTER, CAPACITY, AND AVAILABILITY OF EACH ONE OF THE ARMED FORCES.
- A COMMUNICATION METHOD SHOULD BVE ESTABLISHED IN ORTER TO ALLOW A PERMANENT FLOW OF INFORMATION.

LOGISTIC PROCEDURES

- CFAC MEMBER ARMED FORCES PROVIDE SUPPORT TO THE ARMED FORCES OF OTHER COUNTRIES IN TRANSIT TO THE DISASTER STRICKEN COUNTRY.
- UPON INTEGRATION THE HRU-CFAC MUST HAVE A
 MINIMUM OF FIVE DAYS ECONOMIC AND LOGISTIC
 AUTONOMY, AFTER THE POSSIBILITY OF
 CONTINUING ASSISTING THE AFFECTED COUNTRY
 WILL BE EVALUATED.
