## United Nations Development Program Early Warning and Preventative Measures Process

- 1. Analyse key causes
- 2. Prioritise sectors
- 3. Define specific operational objectives
- 4. Identify potential preventive measures
- 5. Assess UN comparative advantage
- 6. Determine required combination of measures
- 7. Integrate agency participation
- 8. Coordinate operational implementation
- 9. Monitor actions and determine exit criteria




## Regional Desks


- The Regional Desks are the core of the response system.
- The primary function of RCB Regional Desks is the management of OCHA's Emergency Response System






