## 4.0 ASSIGNMENT TERMS OF REFERENCE

The consultant will, in collaboration with the United Nations Education, Science and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) and CDERA, undertake a study of the potential applications of *State-of-the-art* Communications Technology for disaster preparedness and response in the Region. Duties in this regard will include;

- 1. Holding discussions with officials of the specified agencies to determine;
  - (a). The extent to which their current disaster preparedness and response plan incorporate the use of advanced communications technology.
  - (b). Future plans for increasing the use of such technology.
  - (c). The main difficulties or constraints encountered in acquiring and using such technology.
  - (d). State-of-the-art equipment and services available from local and regional service providers.
  - (e). The costs and conditions of use for the services available.
  - (f). Restrictions on the uses of equipment and services.
- 2. Preparing a draft report:
  - Summarizing the findings of the initial survey
  - Offering an interpretation of the findings and indicating how this is likely to affect the strategy to be proposed.
- 3. Presenting the report to a panel of professionals. During the presentation any clarification required will be provided.
- 4. Preparation of a final report which in addition to refining the draft report, includes a proposed strategy for increasing the use of State-of-the-art technology for disaster communications. In preparing this report, due consideration will be given to issues raised and comments made during the review by the panel.
