SPECIAL PURPOSE/SUBJECT EMPHASIS DATABASES RISK ASSESSMENT

INTEGRATED RISK INFORMATION SYSTEM - IRIS (PHNET, TOXNET)

EPA database of chemical specific risk information on 400+ chemicals. Gives reference doses for noncarcinogens; oral slope factors and unit risks for carcinogens; drinking water health advisories; summaries of EPA regulations; and supplementary data (e.g., acute toxicity information and physical-chemical properties). Available through the Public Health Network (PHNET) and is a database in the NLM TOXNET System. Also available on Micromedex Tomes Plus CD-ROM.

SMOKING AND HEALTH

SMOKING AND HEALTH (DIALOG)

Contains bibliographic references and abstracts to journal articles, reports, and other literature that discusses health effects of smoking and secondary smoke exposure. Corresponds to printed Smoking and Health Bulletin. 38,500+ records from 1960 to present (some older material). Produced by the Office of Smoking and Health, U.S. Centers for Disease Control.

TERATOGENICITY/REPRODUCTIVE TOXICOLOGY

DEVELOPMENTAL AND REPRODUCTIVE TOXICOLOGY DATABASE - DART (TOXNET)
DART is a bibliographic database covering teratology and other aspects of developmental and reproductive toxicology. DART, with coverage from 1989 to present, continues the ETICBACK (Environmental Teratology Information Center Backfile) database, which covers primarily teratology information published from 1950-88. Approximately 3,600 records are added to DART each year. Over 50% are derived from MEDLINE, and the remaining records are selected from literature, including technical reports, meeting abstracts, etc., not covered in MEDLINE. ETICBACK contains 46,000+ references from 1950-88. DART and ETICBACK are funded by EPA, ATSDR, and NIEHS and are managed by NLM and made available on the NLM TOXNET System.

REPROTOX (REPRODUCTIVE TOXICOLOGY CENTER)

Provides comprehensive information on the reproductive effects of hundreds of chemical substances. Offers summaries of most relevant and important articles. Database use is included with membership in the Reproductive Toxicology Center.

TERIS (UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON)

Consists of a series of agent summaries, each of which is based on a thorough review of published literature. Each summary includes a rating of the risk of teratogenic effects in the children of women exposed to the agent under the usual conditions of pregnancy. Agent summaries are rated and reviewed by an Advisory Board comprised of nationally-recognized authorities in clinical teratology. An updated, online version of Shepard's Catalog of Teratogenic Agents is available in parallel with TERIS.

SPECIAL PURPOSE/SUBJECT EMPHASIS DATABASES TOXICOLOGY

TOXLINE - TOXICOLOGY INFORMATION ONLINE (MEDLARS, a subset on BRS and a subset on DATASTAR)

Specifically designed to offer comprehensive bibliographic coverage of toxicology information. Covers the pharmacological, biochemical, physiological, environmental, and toxicological effects of chemicals and drugs. Sixteen subfiles including Toxicity Bibliography (TOXBIB) from MEDLINE, Chemical-Biological Activities (CBAC) from Chemical Abstracts, Toxicological Aspects of Environmental Health (BIOSIS) from Biological Abstracts, Pesticides Abstracts (PESTAB), International Pharmaceutical Abstracts (IPA), NIOSHTIC (NIOSH), Toxicology Research Projects from the NIH Computer Retrieval of Information on Scientific Projects database (CRISP), Toxicology Document and Data Depository (NTIS) from NTIS, Hazardous Materials Technical Center of Defense Logistics Agency (HMTC), Environmental Mutagen and Environmental Teratology Information Centers (EMIC and ETIC), International Labour Office CIS Abstracts (CIS), Aneuploidy (ANEUPL), Epidemiology Information System (EPIDEM) of FDA, Toxic Substances Control Act Test Submissions (TSCATS), and the Poisonous Plants Bibliography (PPBIB). Produced by Specialized Information Services of the National Library of Medicine. 2,500,000+ references. TOXLINE with all sixteen subfiles is available NLM MEDLARS System and a thirteen file subset of TOXLINE (excluding CBAC, BIOSIS and IPA) is available on BRS and DATASTAR. The public domain subsets are also available on CD-ROM from SilverPlatter.

TOXICOLOGY DATA NETWORK (TOXNET)

TOXNET is a computerized system of files oriented to toxicology and related areas. It is managed by the National Library of Medicine (NLM) Toxicology Information Program and run on a minicomputer. TOXNET is an integrated system containing modules for building and reviewing records, as well as providing sophisticated search and retrieval features for NLM online users. The TOXNET component files are the Hazardous Substances Data Bank (HSDB), Registry of Toxic Effects of Chemical Substances (RTECS), Chemical Carcinogenesis Research Information System (CCRIS), Directory of Biotechnology Information Resources (DBIR), Developmental and Reproductive Toxicology database (DART) Environmental Teratology Information Center Backfile (ETICBACK), Environmental Mutagen Information Center Backfile (EMICBACK), the Toxic Chemical Release Inventory (TRI), and the EPA Integrated Risk Information System (IRIS).

AQUIRE (CIS)

NATIONAL GROUND WATER INFORMATION CENTER DATABASE (NGWIC)
Indexes the world's ground water literature, including journals, books, federal and state publications, technical reports and reference books. Established by the National Well Water Association under a cooperative agreement with the Environmental Protection Agency.

OCEANIC ABSTRACTS (DIALOG)

Covers marine pollution. Indexes technical literature published worldwide on marine-related subjects; 3,500+ sources cited, including journals, books, technical reports, conference proceedings, and government and trade publications. Produced by Cambridge Scientific Abstracts. 202,000+ records from 1964 to present. In BRS, Oceanic Abstracts is a component of the Cambridge Scientific Abstracts Life Sciences superfile with coverage from 1981 to present.

WATER RESOURCES ABSTRACTS (DIALOG)

Produced by Department of Interior. Prepared from materials collected by over 50 water research centers and institutes in the U.S. 217,000+ records from 1968 to present.

WATERNET (DIALOG)

Provides a comprehensive index of the publications of the American Water Works Association and the AWWA Research Foundation. Includes books and proceedings, journals, newsletters, standards, manuals, handbooks, and water quality standard test methods. 20,000+ records from 1971 to present.

FULL TEXT DATABASES

AP NEWS (DIALOG)

Provides the full text of national, international and business news from the AP DataStream service, available 24 hours after the data was first transmitted. Includes general domestic, political, business and financial, and international news. Coverage from 1984 to the present.
