RISK ASSISTANT (EPA)

This is a PC-based expert system/analytical model under development by Hampshire Research Institute for the EPA Exposure Assessment Group. It is sponsored by EPA, the New Jersey Department of Health, and the California Department of Health Services. It is designed to provide assistance in performing or reviewing an exposure assessment and in evaluating the risks of those exposures. Once a chemical and concentration have been input, Risk Assistant will guide the user through the four basic steps of risk assessment. Risk Assistant has three components:

- 1. Risk Tools which helps the user to perform a complete chemical risk assessment and calls up the appropriate databases as necessary.
- 2. Quick Risk which uses built-in assumptions to allow rapid analysis of the hazards or risks associated with the chemicals found at a site.
- 3. Quick Data which contains four databases: carcinogenic and toxic hazards, Federal and State regulatory standards, chemical properties, and a waste/chemical identification database
