Chapter 1 Basic Principles of the Restoration Plans

Focal Points of Restoration

(1) Urban Conveniences Well-balanced with Safety Precautions

The recent major disaster revealed a vulnerable aspect of city life with its many modern conveniences. To address this problem, we will make it a point to create a city that guarantees safety as well as the conveniences of urban life.

(2) Awareness of Both Benefits and Hazards of Nature

Surrounded by the sea and mountains, Kobe has enjoyed many benefits from its natural environment, but at the same we must remember that nature is not always kind to us. As a matter of fact, the city has experienced a number of natural disasters, including, of course, the recent big earthquake. So we will always keep in mind both the benefits and hazards of nature when we plan our city development. We will also study the city's capacity so as to minimize the stress placed on the environment and to build a city that ensures sustainable development.

(3) Human-to-human Contact and Interchange

Amid the devastation in the aftermath of the big quake, our people stayed calm and helped each other to overcome difficulties resulting from the disaster. We were also greatly encouraged by the support of many groups of volunteer workers, Japanese and otherwise. Our people's civil attitude and the "warmth and kindness" of people who came to help us has convinced us once again that endeavors to develop our community should focus on the well-being of our citizens.
