

NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL RESPONSE

2. DETAILED REPORT FIELD TRIP OF UNDR0 DELEGATE (UNDR0 SITREP NO. 9, 22 DECEMBER 1983, PARA 1) INDICATES THAT ADEQUATE PROPORTION OF FOOD RECEIVED IN DEPARTMENTS FROM LA PAZ IS BEING DISTRIBUTED. IN SEVERAL AREAS EFFECTIVE COLLABORATION REPORTED BETWEEN OFINAAL (GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY IN CHARGE OF FOOD DISTRIBUTION) AND NGO'S (SEQUIA 83, UNITAS, ETC). CO-OPERATION WITH DEPARTMENTAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATIONS (CORDE'S) ALSO REPORTED.

3. DURING MISSION, CLIMATIC CONDITIONS WERE CONSIDERED TO BE IMPROVING. RAIN REPORTED IN SOME AREAS. IF RAIN CONTINUES, 1984 SOWING MAY LEAD TO ADEQUATE HARVEST. HOWEVER, RAINS IN 1983 MIGHT HAVE COME TOO LATE TO SAVE FORTHCOMING HARVEST.

4. IN ALL AREAS VISITED BY DELEGATE, OFINAAL'S LACK OF LIGHT VEHICLES FOR SUPERVISION OF FOOD DISTRIBUTION, VIEWED AS A DIFFICULTY FOR SMOOTH IMPLEMENTATION OF RELIEF PROGRAMMES.

ECUADOR - FLOODS - UNDRO SITREP NO. 13 - 10 AUGUST 1983

SITUATION

1. ON 10 AUGUST 1983, THE U.N. SECRETARY-GENERAL LAUNCHED AN APPEAL TO THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE TO THE POPULATION AFFECTED BY FLOODS IN ECUADOR.

2. UNDRO LAUNCHED AN APPEAL FOR THE VICTIMS OF ECUADOR'S FLOODS IN JANUARY 1983. ON 10 AUGUST, THE SECRETARY-GENERAL REITERATED THE REQUEST THAT UNDRO PURSUE ITS ACTION IN MOBILIZING AND COORDINATING THE INTERNATIONAL EMERGENCY RELIEF EFFORT, ON BEHALF OF THE U.N. SYSTEM.

3. EARLIER IN JUNE, THE SECRETARY-GENERAL APPOINTED A PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE TO DISASTER-STRICKEN COUNTRIES BOLIVIA, ECUADOR AND PERU, TO ADVISE HIM ON THE ASSESSMENT OF EMERGENCY RELIEF REQUIREMENTS AS WELL AS ON ASSISTANCE NEEDS FOR REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION. MR. HUGO NAVAJAS MOGRO, UNDP ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR, VISITED THE WORST-AFFECTED AREAS OF THE THREE COUNTRIES, IN JULY, ACCOMPANIED BY REPRESENTATIVES OF UNDRO, UNDP AND ECLA.

4. FOLLOWING CONSULTATIONS WITH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, REPRESENTATIVES OF DONOR COUNTRIES AND VOLUNTARY AGENCIES, IN EACH OF THE COUNTRIES CONCERNED, DETAILED DOCUMENTS WERE ELABORATED IN WHICH THE EXTENT OF DISASTER DAMAGE AND THE LIST OF IMMEDIATE REQUIREMENTS WERE INCLUDED. THESE DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO THE REPRESENTATIVES ATTENDING THE MEETING OF 10 AUGUST IN NEW YORK.

AFFECTED AREAS AND CASUALTIES

5. AS INDICATED IN PREVIOUS SITREPS ISSUED BY UNDRO, WORST-HIT PROVINCES ARE GUAYAS, LOS RIOS, EL ORO, MANABI AND ESMERALDAS. IT IS NOW ESTIMATED THAT 200,000 PERSONS ARE STILL IN NEED OF EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR THREE MONTHS, DESPITE A PROMPT AND GENEROUS RESPONSE FROM THE INTERNATIONAL DONOR COMMUNITY.

1. ON 10 AUGUST 1983 THE U.N. SECRETARY GENERAL APPEALED TO THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY FOR RELIEF ASSISTANCE TO BOLIVIA, ECUADOR AND PERU. FOLLOWING IS TRANSLATED EXTRACT:

QUOTE - - -

AT THE REQUEST OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF BOLIVIA, ECUADOR AND PERU, AND FOLLOWING RESOLUTION 1983/45 OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL, I WISH ON THIS OCCASION TO LAUNCH AN APPEAL TO YOU, THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY, SO THAT YOU MAY CONSIDER, DUE TO THE URGENCY OF THE SITUATION, THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NEEDS OUTLINED IN THE DOCUMENTS WHICH HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO YOU. IN LAUNCHING THIS APPEAL, I AM CONVINCED THAT BOTH GOVERNMENTS AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS WILL RESPOND, ONCE MORE, IN A PROMPT AND GENEROUS MANNER, SO AS TO ALLEVIATE THE HUMAN SUFFERING IN THE AFFECTED AREAS OF THE THREE COUNTRIES, IN THE BEST TRADITION OF INTERNATIONAL AND HUMAN SOLIDARITY.

SITUATION

1. UNDRO DELEGATE HELD MEETINGS WITH MINISTER SOCIAL WELFARE (NATIONAL EMERGENCY CO-ORDINATOR), OTHER GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, UN AGENCIES AND REPRESENTATIVES 20 MAJOR DONORS.

2. DONORS' MEETING 30 AUGUST: (A) PAHO/WHO ADVISED OF DETERIORATION SANITARY/HEALTH CONDITIONS DUE TO INCREASE VECTOR ACTIVITY RESULTING FROM CONTINUING FLOODING AFTER RENEWED HEAVY RAINS APRIL TO JUNE. IN ESMERALDAS PROVINCE, MALARIA OUTBREAK HAS REACHED EPIDEMIC LEVEL. URGENT NEED TO IMPROVE DRINKING WATER CONTROL IN AFFECTED AREAS. (B) FAO OUTLINED LARGE PRODUCTION LOSSES RESULTING DIRECTLY FROM FLOODS AND INDIRECTLY FROM HALTED AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITY AND NON-AVAILABILITY OF SEEDS. (C) WFP ADVISED THAT EMERGENCY FOOD SITUATION NOW UNDER CONTROL IN VIEW OF NEW FOOD PLEDGES AND CONTRIBUTIONS. (D) IN GENERAL, DONORS WERE INFORMED OF READINESS UN AGENCIES TO ACT AS CHANNELS FOR FUTURE DONATIONS, IN ORDER TO ENSURE CONTROLLED EXECUTION RELIEF AID.

2. SECRETARY-GENERAL HAS ENTRUSTED UNDRO WITH THE TASK OF MOBILIZING AND CO-ORDINATING THE INTERNATIONAL EMERGENCY RELIEF EFFORT ON BEHALF OF THE U.N. SYSTEM.

3. AFFECTED AREAS AND CASUALTIES

5. IN PERU, AS A RESULT OF THE SAME PHENOMENON WHICH AFFECTS BOLIVIA, I.E., A DROUGHT OF EXCEPTIONAL MAGNITUDE AND DURATION, 450,000 PEOPLE ARE IN NEED OF EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF PUNO, AREQUIPA, APURIMAC AND CUZCO. AN AREA OF UP TO 300,000 SQUARE KILOMETRES IS AFFECTED.
