MR. HUGO NAVAJAS MOGRO, UNDP ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR, VISITED THE WORST-AFFECTED AREAS OF THE THREE COUNTRIES, IN JULY, ACCOMPANIED BY REPRESENTATIVES OF UNDRO, UNDP AND ECLA.
- 4. FOLLOWING CONSULTATIONS WITH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, REPRESENT-ATIVES OF DONOR COUNTRIES AND VOLUNTARY AGENCIES, IN EACH OF THE COUNTRIES CONCERNED, DETAILED DOCUMENTS WERE ELABORATED IN WHICH THE EXTENT OF DISASTER DAMAGE AND THE LIST OF IMMEDIATE REQUIRE-MENTS WERE INCLUDED. THESE DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO THE REPRESENTATIVES ATTENDING THE MEETING OF 10 AUGUST IN NEW YORK.

EARLIER IN JUNE, THE SECRETARY-GENERAL APPOINTED A PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE TO BOLIVIA, ECUADOR AND PERU TO ADVISE HIM ON THE ASSESSMENT OF EMERGENCY RELIEF REQUIREMENTS AS WELL AS ON ASSISTANCE NEEDS FOR REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION. MR. HUGO NAVAJAS MOGRO, UNDP ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR, VISITED THE WORST-AFFECTED AREAS OF THE THREE COUNTRIES, IN JULY, ACCOMPANIED BY REPRESENTATIVES OF UNDRO, UNDP AND ECLA.
- 4. FOLLOWING CONSULTATIONS WITH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, REPRESENT-ATIVES OF DONOR COUNTRIES AND VOLUNTARY AGENCIES, IN EACH OF THE COUNTRIES CONCERNED, DETAILED DOCUMENTS WERE ELABORATED IN WHICH THE EXTENT OF DISASTER DAMAGE AND THE LIST OF IMMEDIATE REQUIREMENTS WERE INCLUDED. THESE DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO THE REPRESENTATIVES ATTENDING THE MEETING OF 10 AUGUST IN NEW YORK.

AFFECTED AREAS AND CASUALTIES

- 5. IN PERU, AS A RESULT OF THE SAME PHENOMENON WHICH AFFECTS BOLIVIA, I.E., A DROUGHT OF EXCEPTIONAL MAGNITUDE AND DURATION, 450,000 PEOPLE ARE IN NEED OF EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF PUNO, AREQUIPA, APURIMAC AND CUZCO. AN AREA OF UP TO 300,000 SQUARE KILOMETRES IS AFFECTED.
- 6. THE SITUATION FACING THE COUNTRY HAS BEEN CRITICAL FOR SOME TIME NOW AND AGGRAVATED BY PERSISTING FLOODS IN THE NORTHERN DEPARTMENTS OF PIURA AND TUMBES, FOR WHICH UNDRO LAUNCHED APPEALS FOR ASSISTANCE EARLIER THIS YEAR.
