




### Victoria Hospital Vulnerability Survey

I have left 6 sketches with your Mr Conrad Emmanuel for your consideration.

Perhaps it would be useful if I outlined my understanding of our role in this exercise.

- 1 CEP has been asked to advise PAHO on the vulnerability of the VH to natural hazards.
- 2 CEP has also been asked to recommend details for short-term actions for mitigation of hurricane damage in particular. The hope is that these short-term actions could be implemented this year.
- With respect to item 2, we have issued the 6 above-mentioned sketches to PAHO for consideration.
- 4 PAHO had asked me to deliver these sketches to the Ministry of Health (on PAHO's behalf) which I did this morning.
- I told the MoH that I was to meet with you today to review and discuss the sketches.
- As I see it, it is for you (as the MoH consulting engineer on VH) to consider our proposals and decide whether they should be adopted, adapted or dispensed with. This was to be the main purpose of our meeting today.

With respect to the sketches, I am unhappy about the apparent lack of positive holding-down of the square timber beam in sketch no 3.



I regret that we were unable to meet today. Let me know if you plan to visit Barbados in the near future.






# ITE LAYOUT PLAN









ELEVATION
