On completion of the first exploratory visits to the thirty facilities, ten were identified as having suffered significant damage. Of these ten the Government had already initiated repairs to the St John's Health Centre and Grays Farm I Health Centre.



HOLBERTON GENERAL HOSPITAL

Holberton Medical facility consists of a collection of buildings dispersed over a large campus. The buildings suffered from varying degrees of hurricane damage. Only ones with substantial damage were inspected.

3.1 Gweneth O'Reilly Ward

3.1.1 Description

This is a single storey blockwork building with a gable roof over the main building and a lean-to roof over the open verandah.

3.1.2 Hurricane Damage

Damage was predominantly the loss of roof sheeting and water damage on the inside (photo H.O'R-1). The damaged section of the roof was protected with tarpaulin after the hurricane (photo H.O'R-2).

3.1.3 Inspection

The building had a flat ceiling and the roof frame was not examined.

3.1.4 Repairs

- 1. Replace roof sheeting.
- 2. Install bolts in verandah post.
- 3. Re-attach downpipes.
- 4. Redecorate internally.
- 5. Re-lay vinyl tiles.




Photo H.O'R-1: Water damage on inside of ward.




Photo H.O'R-2: Tarpaulin protecting area of damaged/missing sheeting.
