Asset Protection: A Mission for the National Guard

Abstract

Presidential Executive Order 12656 assigns certain responsibilities to the various Federal department and agencies. The program developed by the Department of Defense (DoD) to meet the requirements of the Executive Order is the DoD Key Asset Protection Program. One of the primary players in this program is the National Guard Bureau and the National Guard in each state. The National Guard has a major role in support of state emergencies beyond this important federal mission. A key example of the different types of missions conducted by State National Guard was seen during the recent Los Angeles riots.
