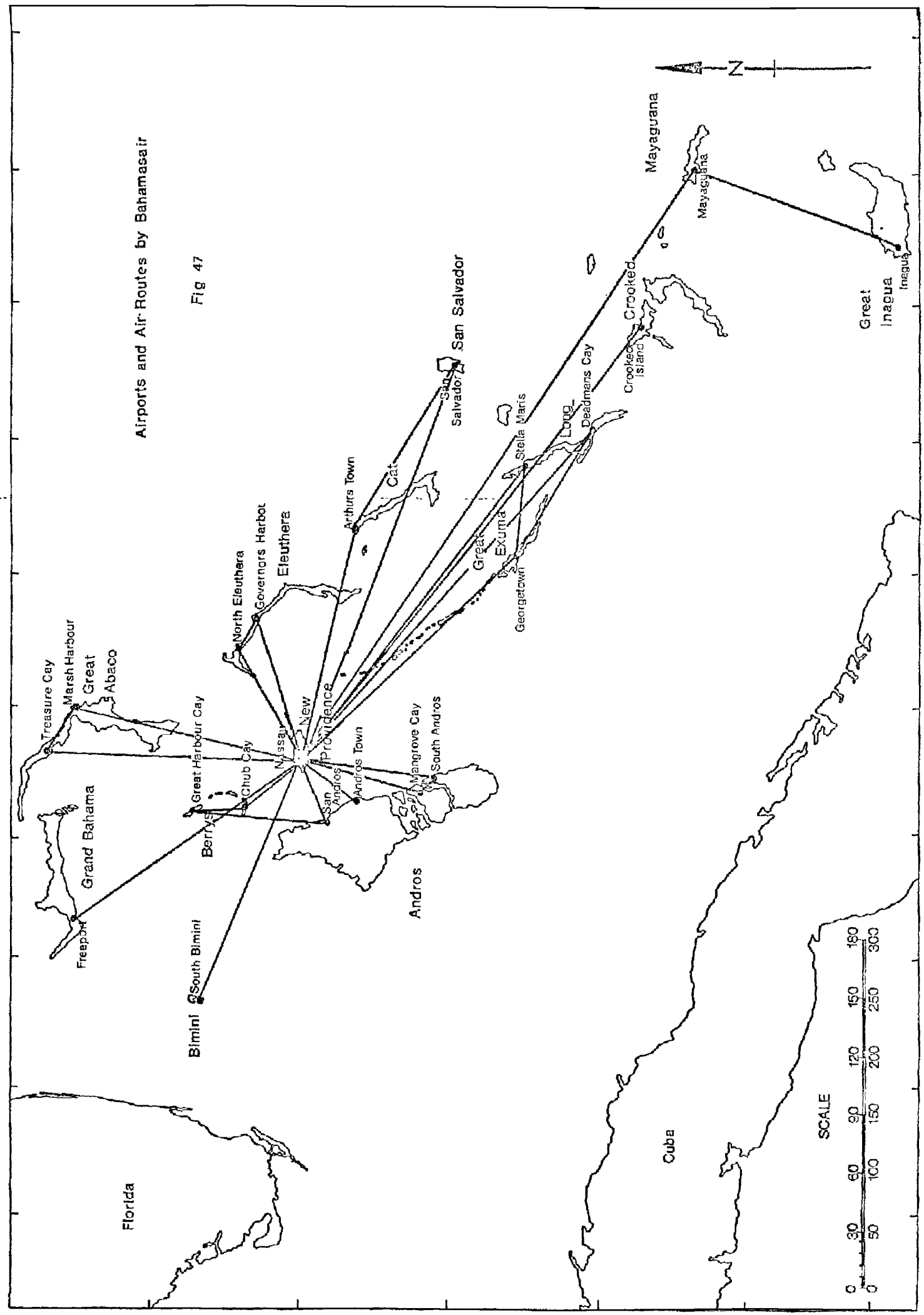

Bahamas Directory of Aerodromes - 1973

1. This is a Directory of Civil and Military aerodromes, airstrips and runways of 2,000 feet or longer, including aerodromes which are restricted due to such reasons as shorter runway or strip lengths, poor state of the surface or the desirability of the private owners to retain exclusiveness of use. These are listed for information only, and are not generally recommended for use except in emergencies.
- 1.1 The aerodromes are listed alphabetically by the islands on which they are located. The islands also appear in a similar order.
2. All aeroplanes must have prior approval to land at United States Military Bases. Clearances may be obtained from H.Q. Air Force Missile Tracking Centre, Patrick AFB, Governors Harbour, Eleuthera, Bahamas.

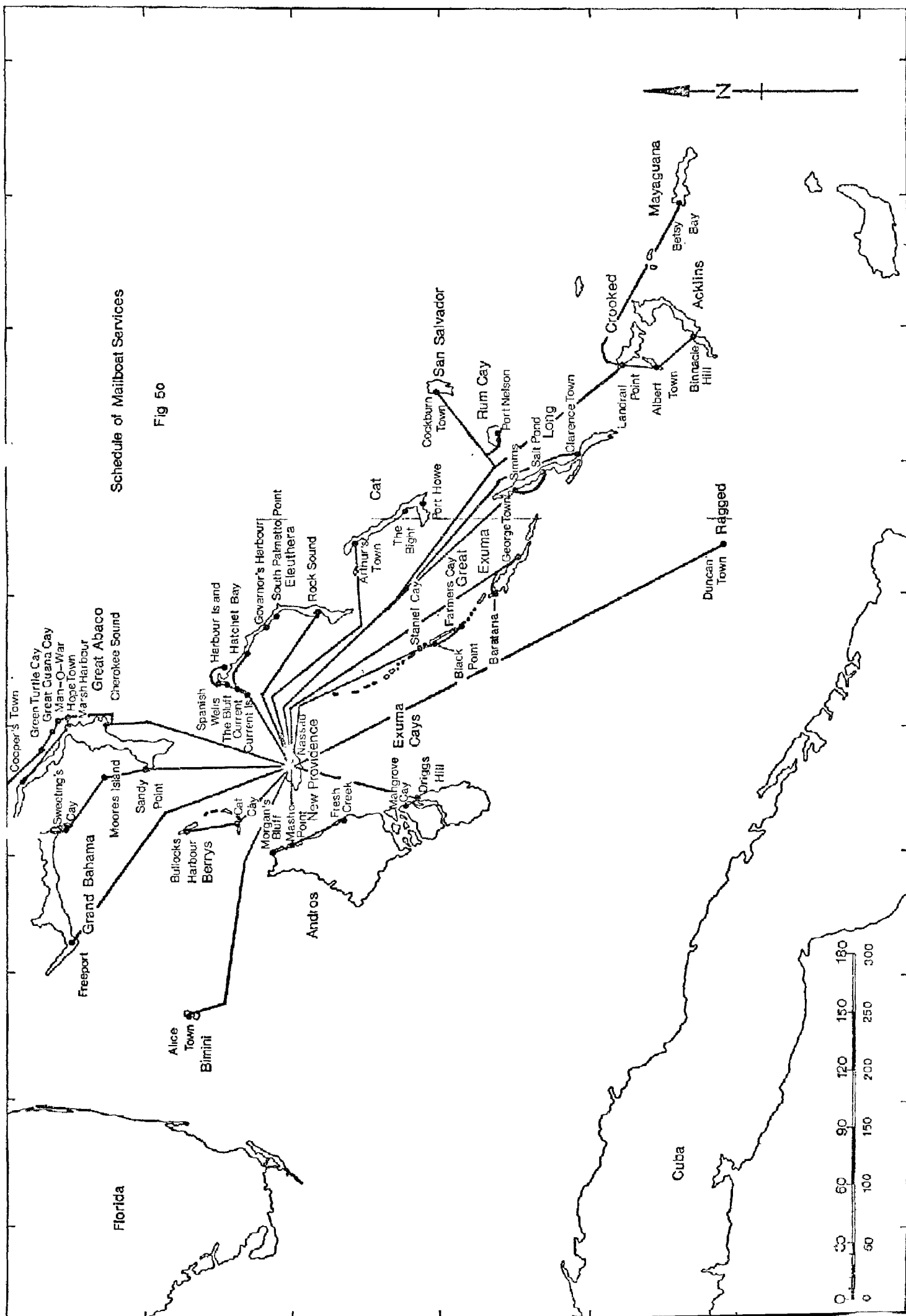

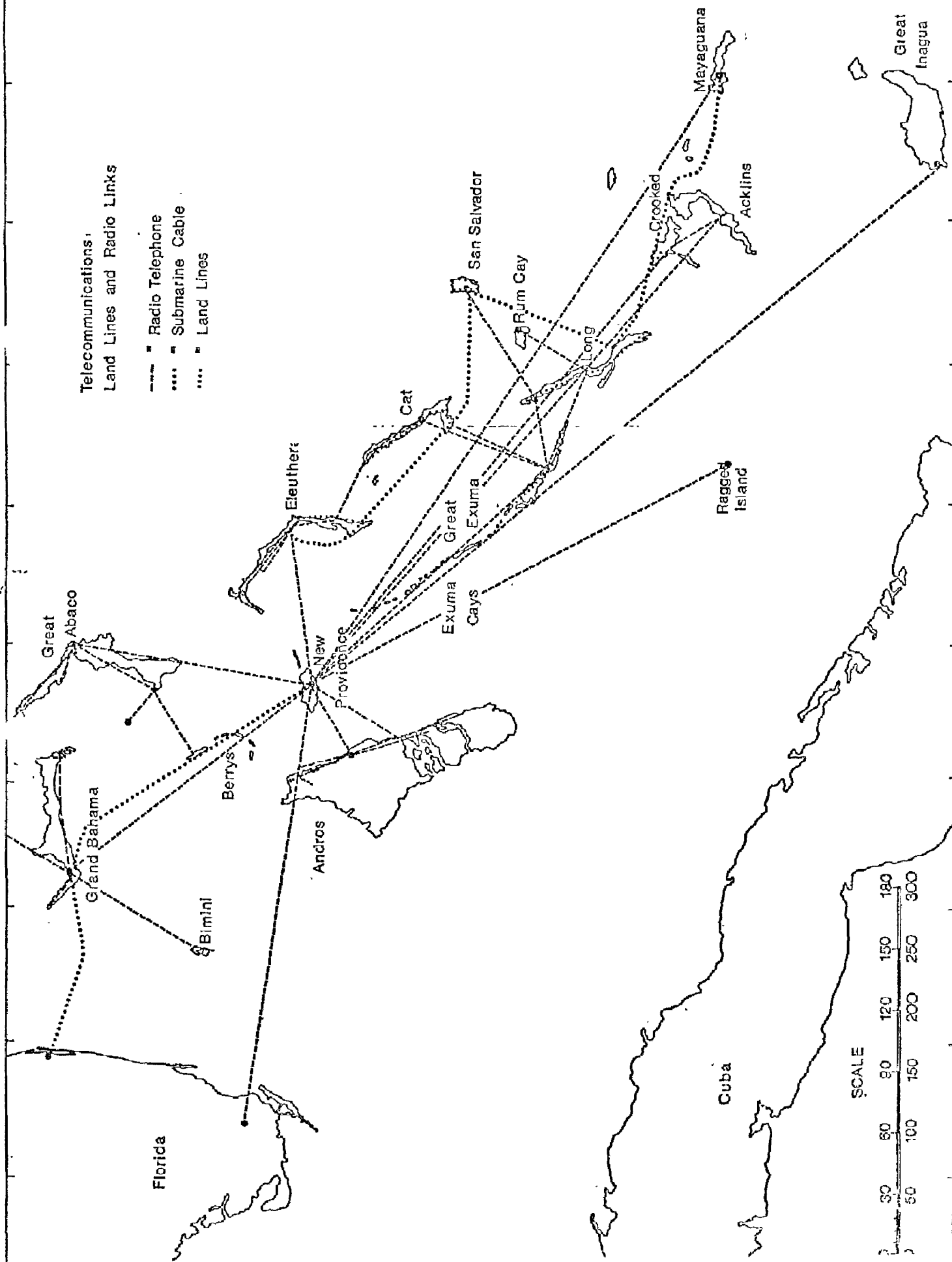

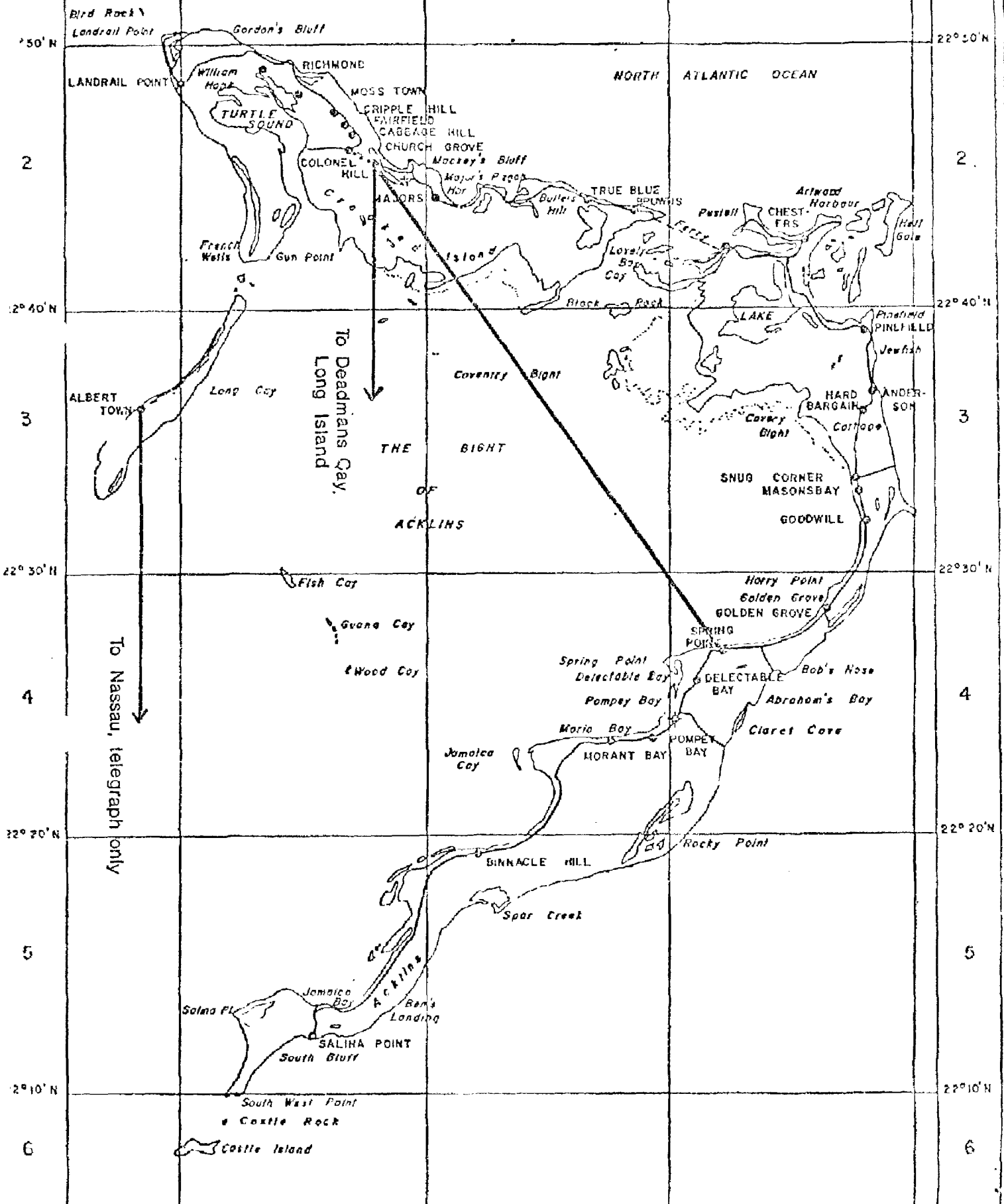

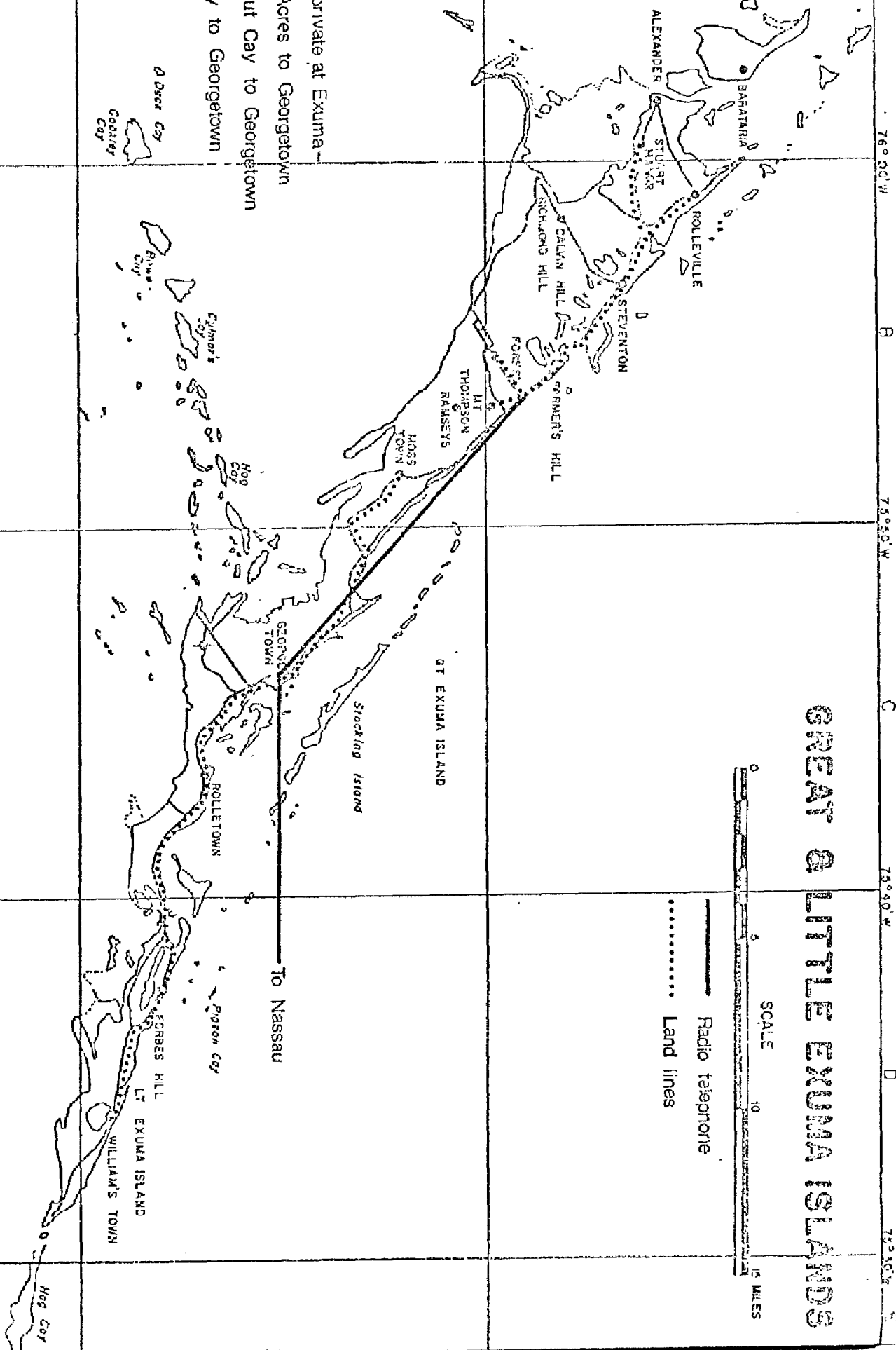

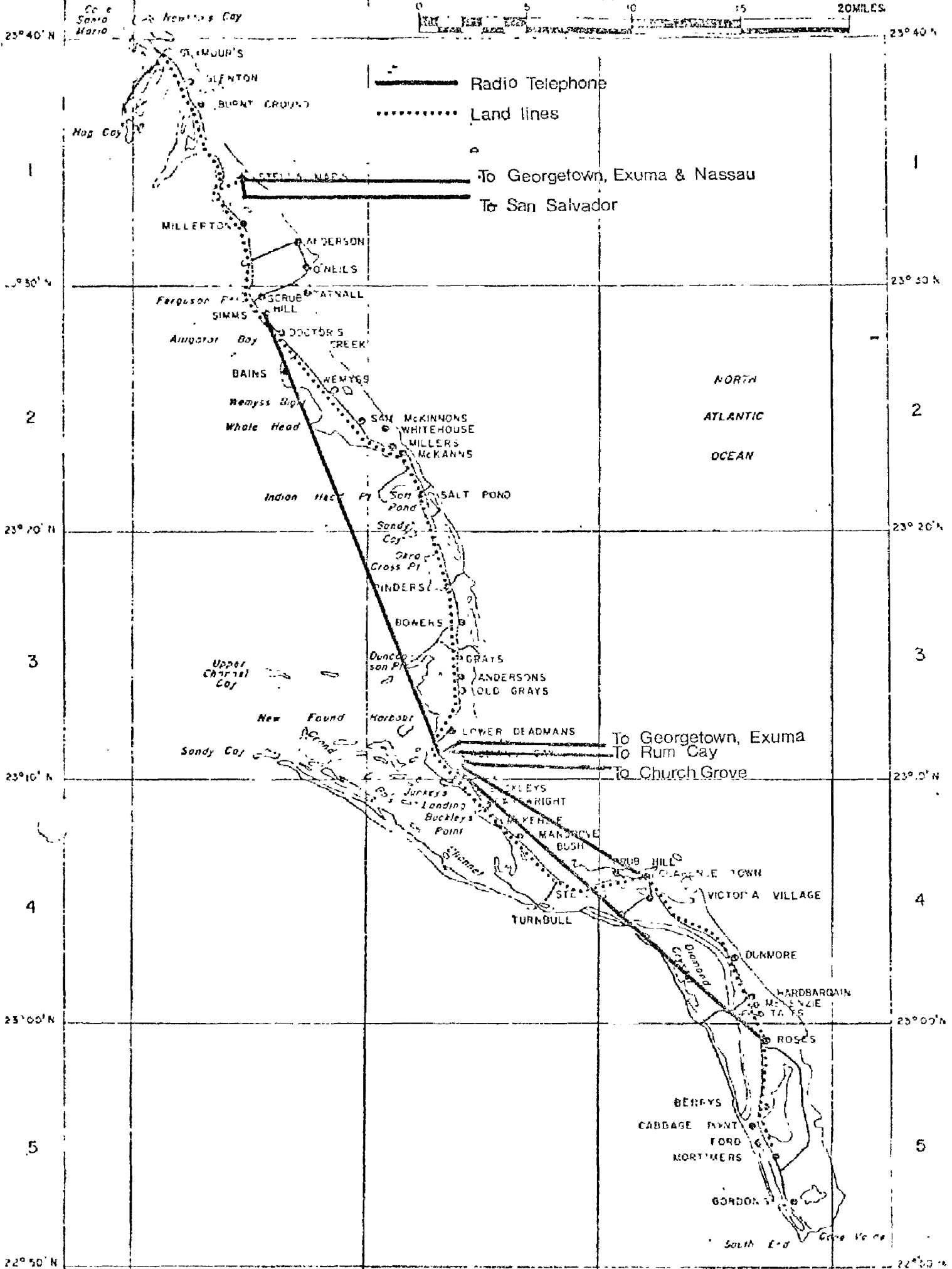

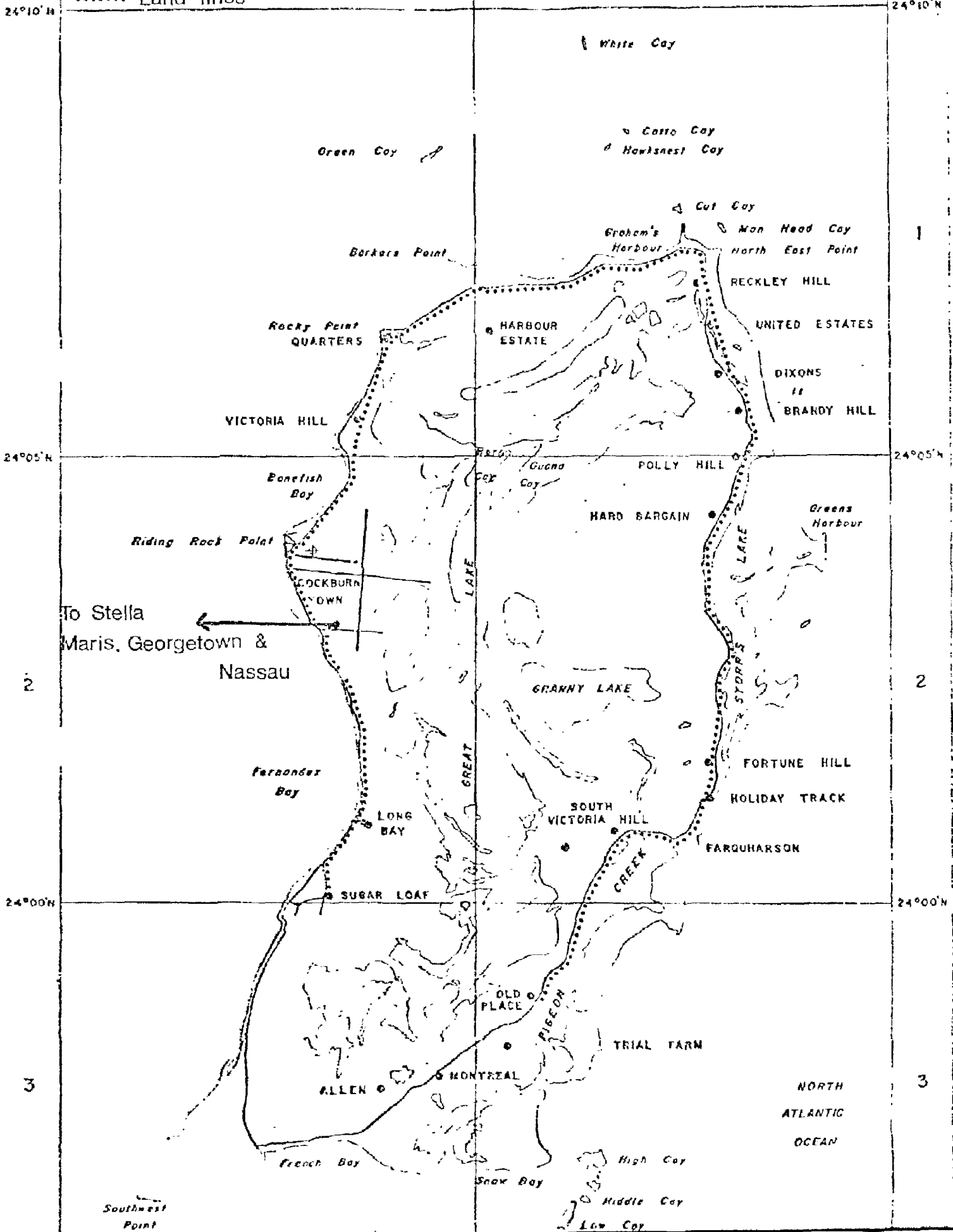

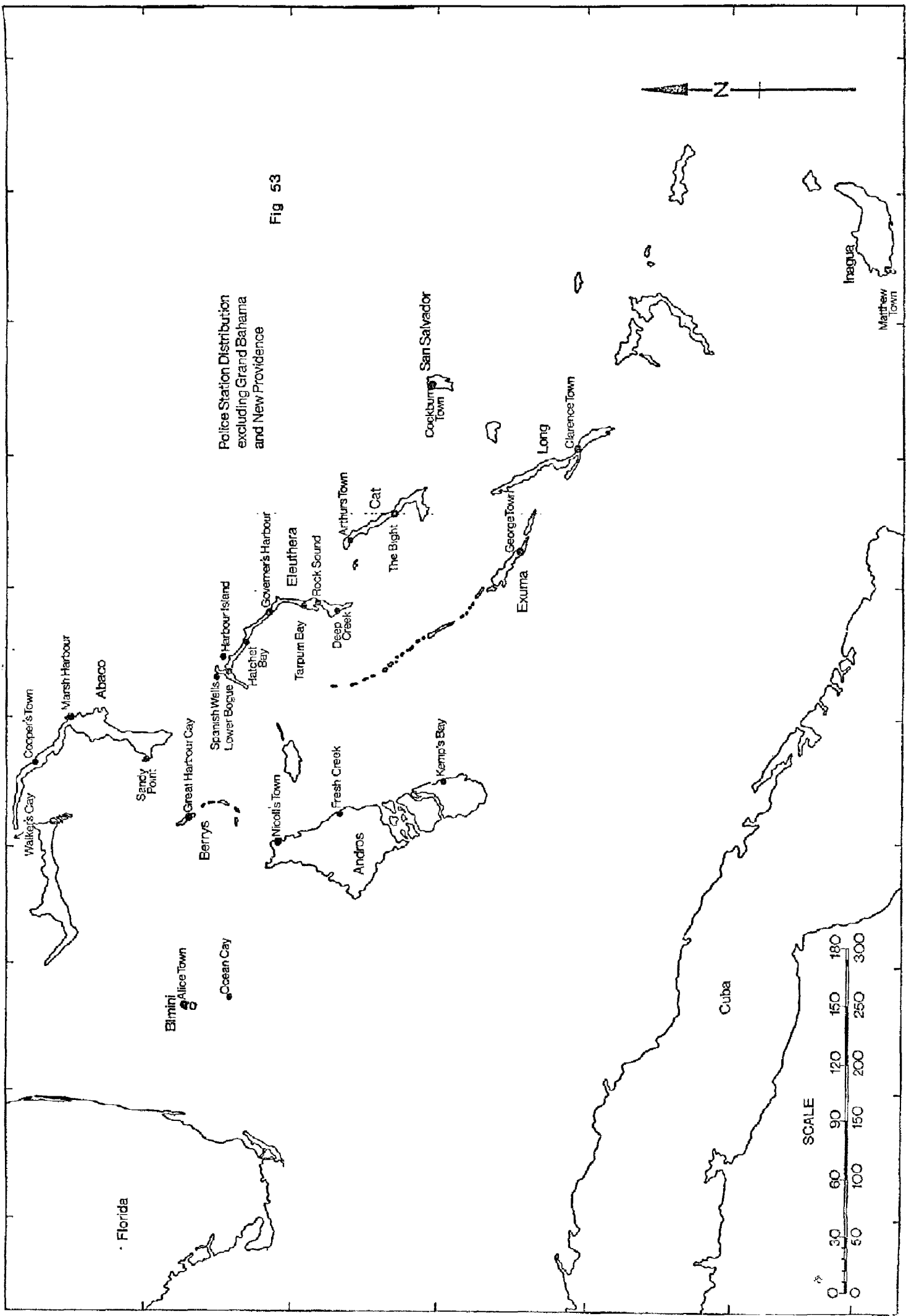

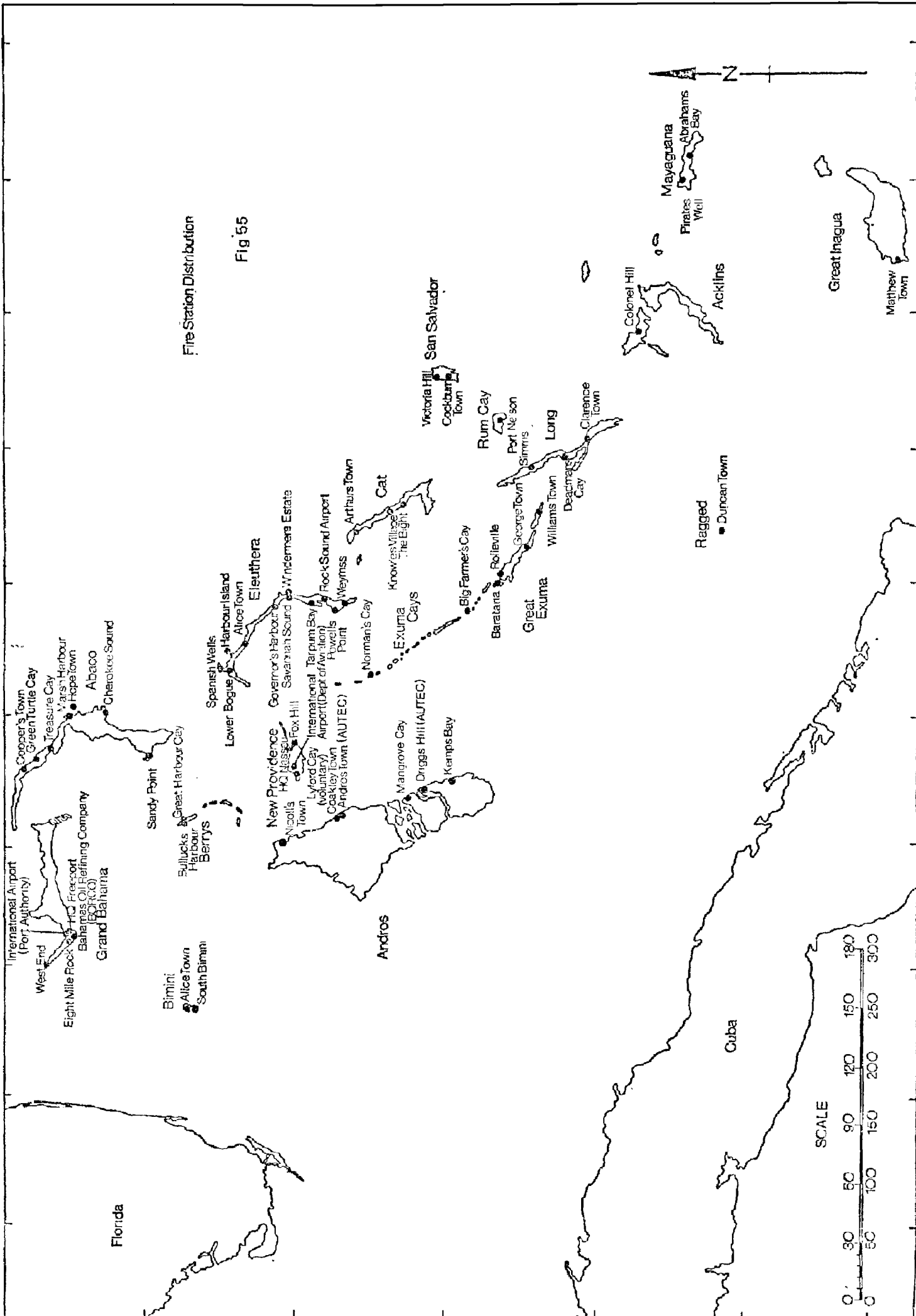

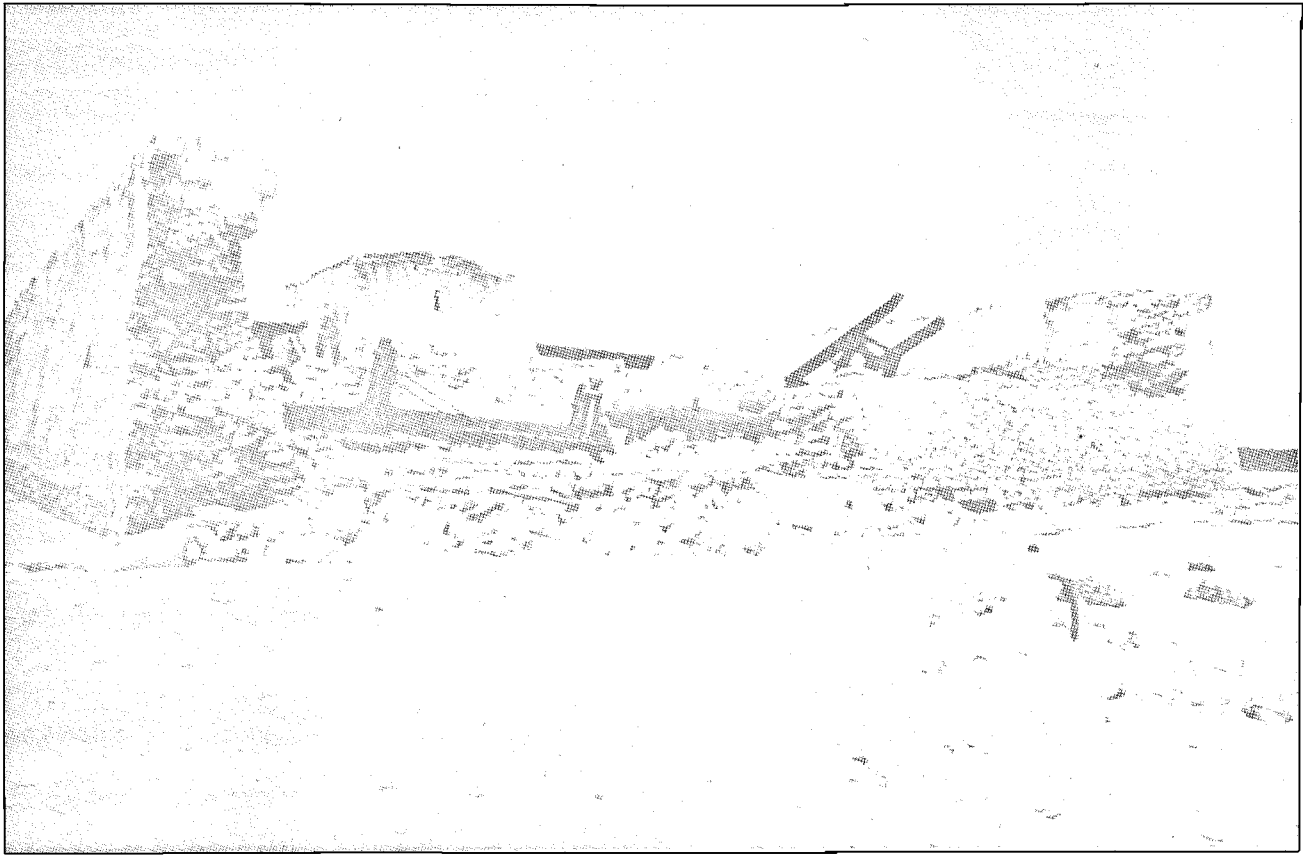
