This document complements the information containing in the Report of the Secretary-General of the Conference on national activities for natural disaster reduction (A/CONF.172/4/Add.1).

Table 1

Table 1 indicates the composition of national committees and/or focal points according to the recommendations included in the report of the Secretary-General submitted to the General Assembly (E/1989/114/Add.1-A/44/322/Add.1) and endorsed by the Assembly in resolution 42/169.

Considering the potential range of measures required to reduce the impact of a natural disaster on a particular nation or community, the need for inter-disciplinary and inter-sectoral involvement is apparent. It also becomes evident that those public and private functionaries responsible for disaster reduction activities and socio-economic activities must be involved. This must necessarily be reflected in the composition or membership of national committees.

It is therefore recommended that a national committee should be composed of representatives of responsible ministries, government bodies and services, research and scientific institutions, non-governmental organizations, the media and the private sector, especially insurance companies.

Table 2 summarizes the information provided in the national reports concerning prevailing hazards, number of recent disasters, the population affected and the amount of economic losses.

Furthermore, assistance available to other countries and/or assistance required from external resources in the form of know-how, technical equipment and financial assistance is listed whenever information was provided in the reports.

Table 3 provides information on disaster mitigation activities completed or under way according to the framework for technical activities adopted by the Scientific and Technical Committee (STC) for the IDNDR at its first session in March 1992 (IDNDR/STC/1991/8).

Under the following areas of activities number and costs of projects, sources of funding (national/external) and status of implementation are indicated.

1) Identification of hazard zones

This concerns scientific studies of the potentially destructive natural phenomena to which the country is exposed and should include vulnerability and risk assessment in co-operation with disaster management agencies.

2) Monitoring, prediction and warning

Monitoring and prediction activities include the installation or augmentation of observational networks. The issuing of warning requires correct interpretation of scientific data and its translation into a language that can be readily understood by the public.

3) Short-term protective measures and preparedness

In response to the existence of a known hazard and especially in response to predictions or warnings of impending events, much can be done by short-term or temporary protective actions to reduce the vulnerability of people and property.

4) Long-term preventive measures

This category includes all long-term or permanent measures that may be taken to reduce the vulnerability of the population and of structures (housing, industrial plants, urban lifelines, etc.). These may be divided into non-structural measures and structural measures.

5) Land use and risk management

Local and national legislation and planning is required to provide a sound basis for all other preventive measures. Risks and losses due to natural disasters can to some extent be controlled by appropriate land use, by siting of human settlements and facilities in less hazardous zones and by the application of proper building codes.

6) Public information and education

This category involves training of the public or government officials and political and public information programmes in order to increase the awareness for natural disaster reduction and to influence the behaviour of the population during and after a disaster occurs.
