FOREWORD

This is the Commonwealth of Kentucky Emergency Operations Plan (Ky EOP). The Ky EOP is applicable to local and state governments and shall apply to natural, technological and war related emergencies and disasters.

Annexes to the EOP are functional and expand upon the concept of operations contained in the basic plan. Annexes provide specific responses for agencies of state government and define responsibilities of local government.

The Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) required for the implementation of the Ky EOP are not included because of the voluminous nature of the SOPs. SOPs are the detailed operating procedures of cabinets and agencies and are maintained by the departments.

An annual review of the EOP will be undertaken by Ky DES and those agencies, departments and cabinets of state government having emergency assignments.

This plan provides for the rendering of equal service to all persons within the Commonwealth regardless of age, sex, religion, nationality, race or physical or mental handicaps.

WHEREAS, Executive Orders 75-503, dated June 2, 1975, 81-426, dated May 19, 1981, 84-534, dated June 27, 1984, and 88-518, dated July 11, 1988, outlined certain responsibilities and authority of the Division of Disaster and Emergency Services and the Adjutant General to plan and coordinate disaster and emergency preparedness, response, and recovery for the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, State departments and agencies and their DES coordinators play a vital role in emergency preparedness; and

WHEREAS, an increasing number of emergencies in the Commonwealth and changes in the federal emergency preparedness program require that certain changes be made in Kentucky's procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Adjutant General has recommended to the Governor that said changes in procedures be made:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRERETON C. JONES, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky; in conformity with Executive Orders 75-503, 81-426, 84-534, and 88-518; and in accordance with the provisions of KRS 39.400 through 39.900, all appropriate federal laws, and national plans for emergency preparedness and disaster response promulgated by the President of the United States, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, or any other agency of the Federal Government having authority within the scope of KRS Chapter 39, do hereby order and direct the following:

1. The Division of Disaster and Emergency Services, Department of Military Affairs, shall be the agency of State Government having primary responsibility and authority for the planning and execution of disaster and emergency preparedness, response, and recovery for the Commonwealth; for the coordination of disaster and emergency response by and between State agencies and political subdivisions; for coordination and liaison with related agencies of the Federal Government and other states; for coordination with concerned private agencies dealing in emergency services; for coordination of all recovery operations subsequent to disaster and emergencies; and for coordination of hazard mitigation planning activities.

2. The Adjutant General shall:

(A) Prepare and submit for the Governor's approval a comprehensive plan and program for the disaster and emergency response of this State, such plan and program to be integrated into and coordinated with the disaster and emergency response plans of the Federal Government and of other states to the fullest possible extent, and coordinate the preparation of plans and programs for disaster and emergency response by the counties and cities of this State, such plans to be integrated into and coordinated with the disaster and emergency response plan and program of this State to the fullest extent.

(B) In accordance with such plan and program for the disaster and emergency response of the State, ascertain the requirements of the State and of the counties and cities thereof for food or clothing or other necessities of life in the event of disaster or attack, and plan for and, with the approval of the Governor, procure supplies, medicines, materials, and equipment, and use and employ from time to time any of the property, services, and resources within the State, for the purposes set forth in Chapter 39 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and institute training programs and public information programs in support of such disaster and emergency response.

(C) Sponsor and develop mutual aid plans and agreements among the counties and cities of this State and, with the approval of the Governor, with other states.

(D) Notify the Governor immediately in the event of occurrence, or threatened or pending occurrence, of any of the events or circumstances contemplated by KRS 39.400 or KRS 39.401, and recommend in such notice all actions and emergency powers which the Governor should thereupon execute.

(E) Notify the Governor of the appropriation necessary to fund the Commonwealth's share of the grants provided by PL 93-288, Title IV, Federal Disaster Assistance Programs as amended by PL 100-707, the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, or successor Acts or Titles and, further, take action necessary to ensure entitlement to all other federal relief or assistance programs.



3. Each cabinet of State Government shall appoint and designate to the Adjutant General a Disaster and Emergency Services Coordinator and alternate, and each department or other agency of State Government shall cooperate with and assist the Adjutant General in developing plans to ensure the performance of such disaster or emergency duties assigned by the Governor or by the Adjutant General with the Governor's approval.
