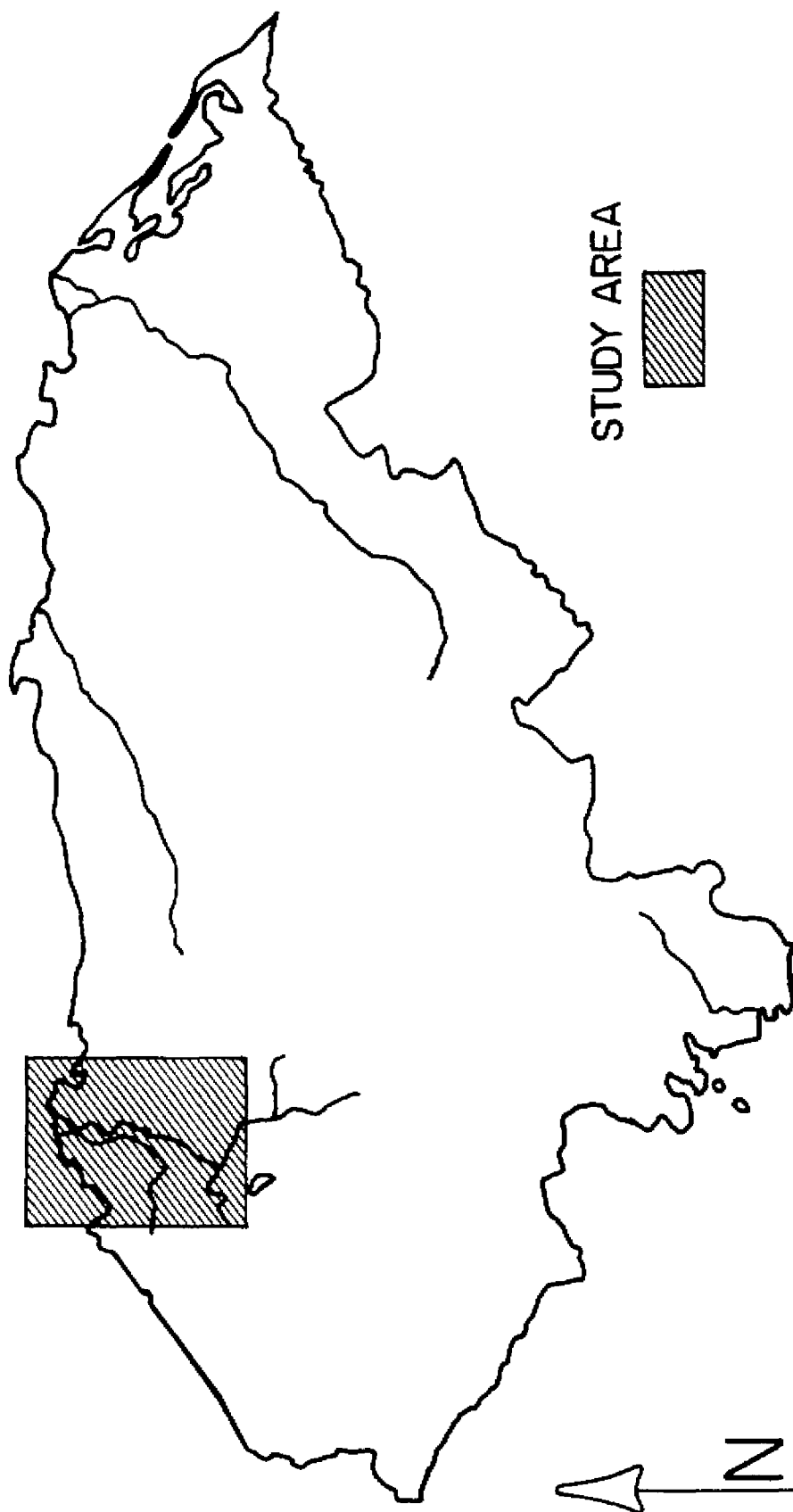


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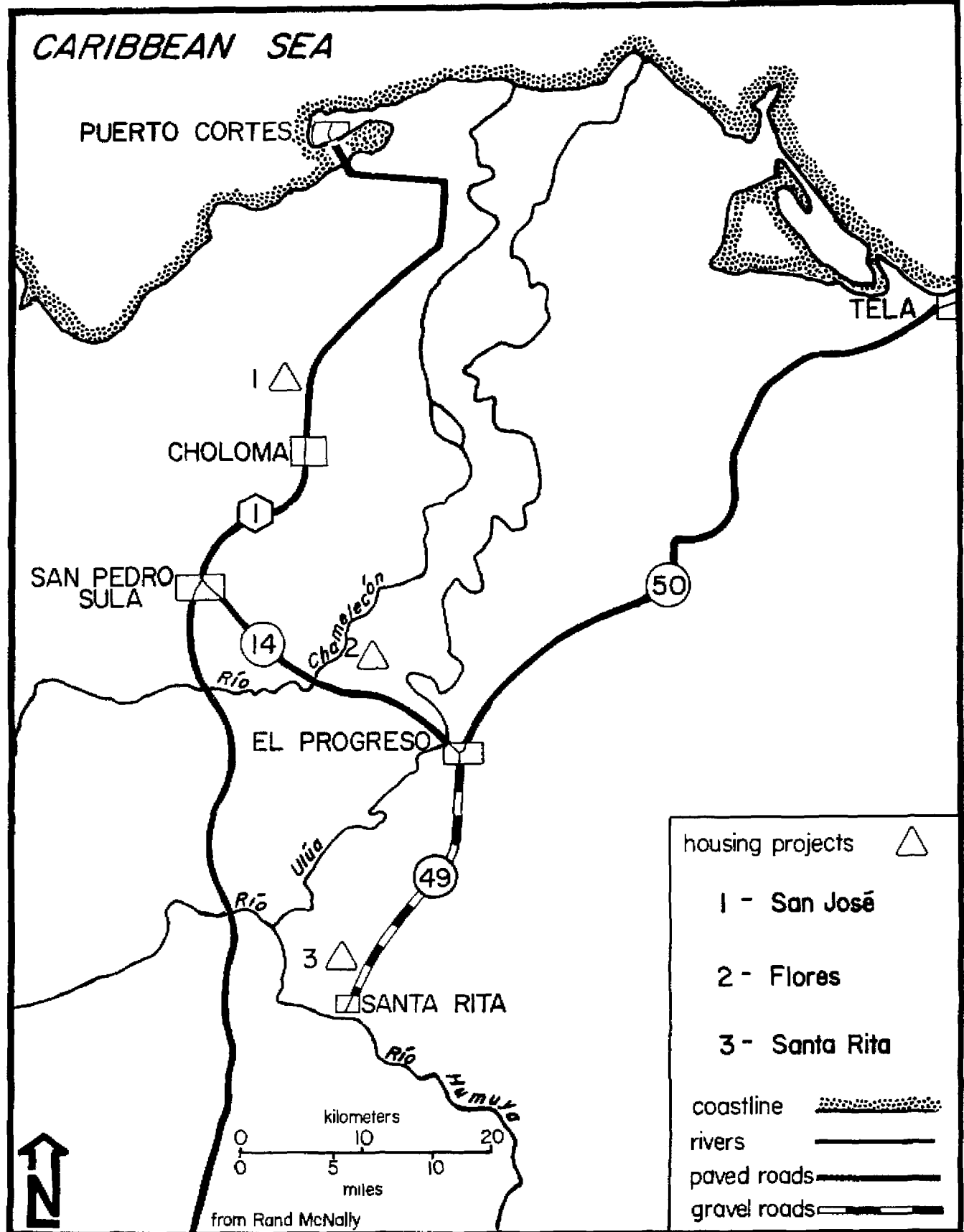

## FORWARD

This is the final phase of a three phase study of families who received houses built for victims of Hurricane Fifi, which struck the northern coast of Honduras on September 18, 1974. Phase one of the study (Summer, 1976) concentrated on collecting base data on the housing recipients. Phase two (Summer, 1977) utilized about a forty percent sample of the recipients and focused on occupant satisfaction and housing goal realization. Phase three (Summer, 1978), reported herein, concentrates on attrition and housing improvement. Unlike the previous two studies this third phase surveyed only the three projects that were sponsored, from the beginning, by Church World Service (CWS) through Comité Evangelico de Desarrollo y Emergencia Nacional (CEDEN) of Honduras. Readers desiring descriptions of the three projects should see Field Report No. 2.

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
